### Show Waiver

I \_\_\_\_\_ am entering the horse named \_\_\_\_\_ at my own risk and agree to abide by FQHR rules. I acknowledge that horseback riding and competition is a sport, which carries inherent risks to me and all those handling and exhibiting my horse. I knowingly assume all risks. In consideration of my indemnity, I hold TFQHC, FQHR, AQHA and all Fairgrounds/Equestrian Centers harmless against all claims, demands and causes of action, including court costs and damage proceedings. This includes lawsuit brought on by or prosecuted for my benefit. There will be NO refunds of stall fees or cattle charges after the deadline without a veterinarian certificate and all fees are to be paid prior to leaving the event. My signature acknowledges that I have read the liability release and agree to all conditions here-in.

**Class refunds** will be given only in the following instances:

1. Sudden death or tragedy in the immediate family
2. Horse is obviously lame or ill

If you have pre-registered and can't make it to the show due to one of the above reasons you must submit proof to TXFQHC within seven days post show. You will not receive a refund on cattle/stall or office fees, only class fees.

Pre-entries should include the following:

1. Signed 'waiver' form
2. Copy of current negative coggins
3. Copy of horses FQHR papers
4. Copy of current FQHR membership for both owner and rider
5. Amateur and Novice Amateur entries need copies of membership cards
6. All cattle fees and stall fees

(post entries on cattle classes depend on cattle availability)

**Failure to provide the above information with entry forms will result in a \$10.00 office charge the day of the show and you must have these items to compete.**
